



"RENATO BRUSON" ACADEMY MASTER FOR OPERA SINGERS

Duration: Six months, from January 27th, 2018 - to July 30th, 2018.

Necessary Requirements for Admission: singers who are at the age of 22 till age of 36 for women and 38 for men, and have a degree in singing at a State Music Conservatory or a Musical Institute, Italian or foreign. If the studies have been completed at a private music school or private teacher, the Director or the teacher must, under his or her own responsibility, certify a student's eligibility statement.

Selection: Entry to the course is subordinated to the passing of a preselection examination (as detailed in the Call for Admission at article n. 6).

Location: "Renato Bruson Academy" is headquartered in Villa Pallavicino, via Ferdinando Provesi, Busseto .

Costs: The candidate who passes the selection will have to enroll at the Master course by paying the amount of Euros 4.000,00 = according to the following rates:

1.000,00 euros at the time of moment of enrollment;

2.000,00 euros at January 30th, 2018;

1.000,000 euros at April 30th, 2018.

Deadline for enrollment to preselection: Deadline of enrollment to the selection is on 30th October 2017, deadline of enrollment to the Academy course is within 30th November 2017.

Auditions: auditions are scheduled to take place in Parma on 7th and 8th November 2017. The organization reserves to confirm these dates, or to modify them, or to add a further day if number of singers enrolled are so many.

REGULATION

Call for admission to "RENATO BRUSON ACADEMY" Year 2018

Singers can entry to the Academy after selection. Singers will be selected if they have artistic and vocal qualities to deserve a perfecting career for a lyrical artist, based on sound vocal, musical, theatrical and cultural vocational training.

The course lasts six months, from 27th January till 30th July 2018.

1. The didactic program includes: voice interpretation of opera repertoire and chamber music; Study of the score: Diction and Italian Language Course for Foreigners. There are also meetings, seminars and lectures on stage interpretation.

During the course are also planned concerts, at the end of the course M° Renato Bruson will decide to prepare the suitable students for the repertoire of opera.

2. Teacher of Voice Interpretation: M° Renato Bruson.

3. Course will be held in Academy, in via Ferdinando Provesi, Villa Pallavicino, Busseto.

4. Requirements:

They can enroll those who:

- a) Who are at the age of 22 till age of 36 for women and 38 for men,
- b) They have obtained the 1st degree level academic (or any equivalent and / or higher qualification) at the State Music Conservatory or a Musical Institute, Italian or foreign. If the studies have been completed at a private music school or private teacher, the teacher, under his or her own responsibility, must certify a student's eligibility statement.

5. Selection

Candidates who intend to sign up for the selections will have to send an email to segreteria@accademiabruson.com, enrollment for the selections provides for a symbolic fee of 35,00 euros to be paid by bank transfer to the Iban coordinates communicated by the secretariat of the Academy (or on website if singers will fill the form online). The application must arrive by October 20, 2017.

For the selection phase, the candidates will have to present 3 lyric arias through a first eliminatory test and a final test: the songs will have to be drawn from lyric works, of which 2 in Italian and 1 in another language, or arias taken from the repertoire cameristico and / or from the repertoire of sacred music.

The Examiner Commission has the opportunity to listen to all or part of the required passages and also the possibility of limiting the hearing to a part of the planned program.

The singers will have to provide at the hearing the scores of the selected songs, which will be performed at the piano by a pianist of the "R. Bruson Academy".

6. Application for admission and deadline for submission.

The application for admission can be submitted online from www.accademiabruson.com, complete with relevant documentation, and sent by November 30th, 2017. The application can also be sent by email to segreteria@accademiabruson.com. The application must be accompanied by the following documents:

- a scanned copy of an identity document (identity card or passport);
- a scanned copy of certification of musical and vocal studies, as indicated in point 4 above;
- curriculum vitae;
- a photo.

7. Enrollment at the Academy.

Candidates selected for admission to Academy, for advanced course in Voice Interpretation, will have to pay the registration fee of Euro 4.000,00 by transfer bank to the Iban and Swift coordinates provided by the Secretariat of the Academy and with the possibility of dividing the share into three tranches:

- 1.000,00 euros at the time of enrollment;
- 2.000,00 euros by January 30th, 2018;
- 1.000,000 euros in balance by April 30th, 2018.

The registration fee will not be refunded.

According to Italian law, the application for registration implies the following declaration:

“The undersigned aware of the penal sanctions provided for in art. 76 D.P.R. 28/12/2000 n. 445 for the case of false declarations and false acts, declares pursuant to art. 46 and 47 D.P.R. 445/2000 that what is contained in the documents / curriculum is true. In addition, the undersigned authorizes the processing of personal data for the purpose of using the curriculum, according to DL 30/06/2003 n. 196”.

8. Italian Language Course for Foreigners.

Foreigners who intend to attend the Italian Language course to complete the exam for obtain the PLIDA level, Level B1 and Level B2 certification, will have to attend the lessons and they will have to pay an additional fee of € 250,00 for the exam.

9. Final Certification

At the end of the entire course, evaluating the overall performance and achievement of the objectives identified for each student by the Artistic Directorate of the Academy, will be issued a diploma of the Academy that will be:

- High degree with praise;
- High degree diploma;
- PLIDA Certification for Italian Language, Level B1 and Level B2 for foreigners supporting the exam.

Some scholarships will also be awarded to the most deserving students with Opera Lirica debut.

Diplomas and scholarships are bound to the actual presence during the course months.

The course attendance is compulsory. Any absences will not exceed 30% of the total number of lessons per candidate.

10. Admission of non-EU candidates

Candidates who are not resident in one of the EU Member States will have to submit at least one month before the start date of the lessons the documentation required by the law of non-EU countries and the provisions of the Italian Public Security (application for a residence permit for study purposes).

11. Language of application.

Applicants residing abroad must apply for admission as well as the documents required for enrollment at the Academy with translation into Italian or English language.

12. Listener Students

They are admitted to the lessons of M ° Renato Bruson listening students. Each student will have to pay a fee of 30 euros per day. The request must be sent by email to segreteria@accademiabruson.com
